
Municipality of Primošten Welcome





Saint Rocco's Church in Primošten was built in the 17th century as a gesture of gratitude to Saint Rocco for protecting the town from the plague. Located close to the Old Town and Don Ivo Šarić Park, it is an important part of Primošten's cultural and religious heritage.

This is the town's most splendid green area and a peaceful oasis in the heart of Primošten. The park is part of the promenade through the Old Town of Primošten and is a popular place for relaxing and spending time with friends. Cypresses and Mediterranean vegetation give it an air of calm and comfort.

The Wind Rose

This large floor mosaic, set on the renewed waterfront promenade, lies near the statue of the Primošten fisherman.

Their proximity illustrates how important and closely bound they are in the Primošten fishing tradition and heritage. The Wind Rose symbolizes the fisherman's bond with the sea and nature, and bears witness to his skill in navigating the open seas.
